- ¹ Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. [a]
- ² I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."
- ³ Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence.
- ⁴ He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.
- ⁵ You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day,
- ⁶ nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday.
- ⁷ A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.
- ⁸ You will only observe with your eyes and see the punishment of the wicked.
- ⁹ If you say, "The LORD is my refuge," and you make the Most High your dwelling,
- no harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent.

- ¹⁵ He will call on me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him.
- ¹⁶ With long life I will satisfy him and show him my salvation."

"That is why I tell you not to worry about everyday life—whether you have enough food and drink, or enough clothes to wear. Isn't life more than food, and your body more than clothing? Look at the birds. They don't plant or harvest or store food in barns, for your heavenly Father feeds them. And aren't you far more valuable to him than they are? Can all your worries add a single moment to your life?

"And why worry about your clothing? Look at the lilies of the field and how they grow. They don't work or make their clothing, yet Solomon in all his glory was not dressed as beautifully as they are. And if God cares so wonderfully for wildflowers that are here today and thrown into the fire tomorrow, he will certainly care for you. Why do you have so little faith?

"So don't worry about these things, saying, 'What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?' These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs. Seek the Kingdom of God[a] above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need. "So don't worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring its own worries. Today's trouble is enough for today.
